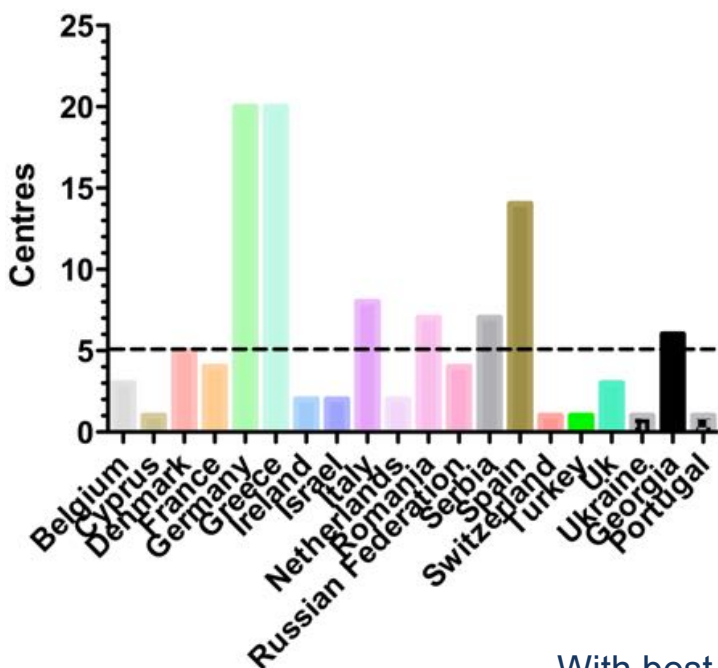
### Important notice:

1. It is of utmost importance to perform the 30 days follow-up for the success of our POSE-study. The peri-interventional all-cause **mortality rate until day 30** is our **primary endpoint!** If you cannot reach the patient on day 30, please try to contact his/her next of kin. If you do not reach anybody on day 30, please try it also one day later! 2. Intra-arterial line for blood pressure measurement is corresponding to "Invasive RR" within the questions about the advanced intra-interventional/operative monitoring! This information is now added to our Appendix 2 Case report form Version 1.3
