- Data cleaning has advanced further. Already 137 of 177 centres have passed the process and received their certificates.

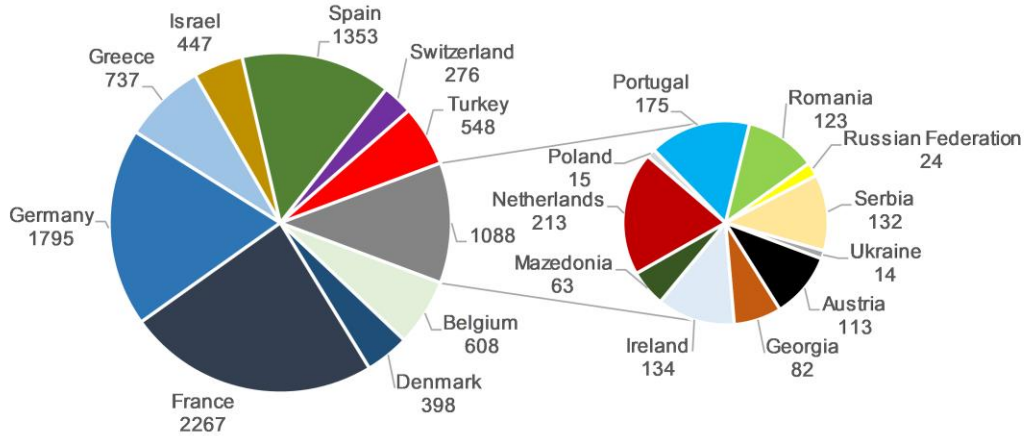

### Investigator and SC Meeting was held on 2<sup>nd</sup> June

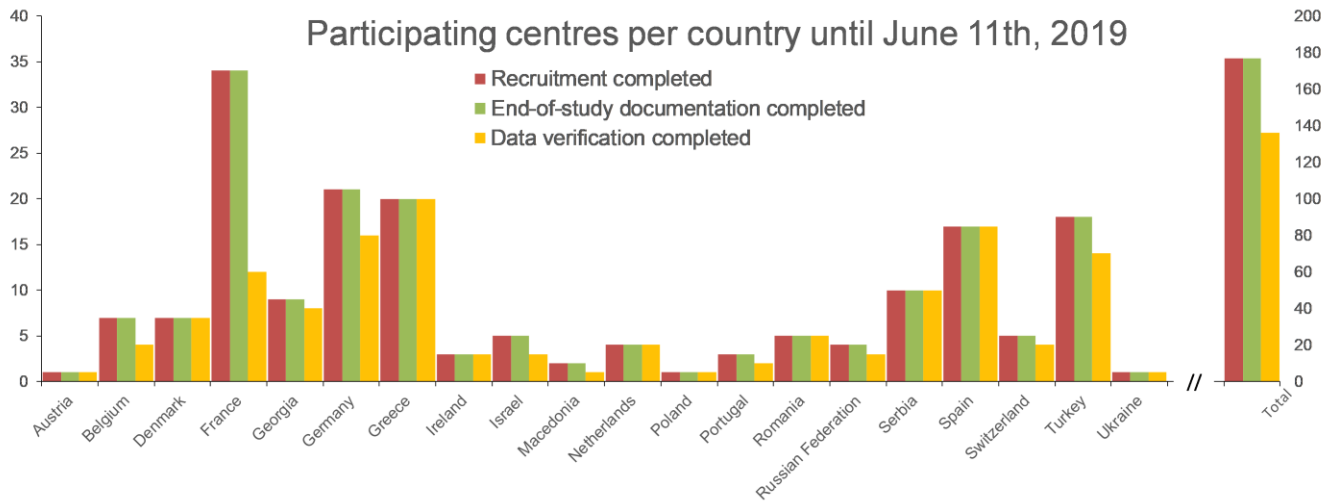
